



Police Chief - Rama First Nation



The Chippewas of Rama First Nation, a proud and progressive community, is seeking a dynamic and seasoned professional to serve our Community as the Chief of Police. The Rama Police Service believes in and practices Community Policing. The successful applicant must have a strong belief in and comprehensive understanding of Community Policing.

Reporting to the Rama Police Service Board, the desired applicant will need to have demonstrated success in gaining and sustaining the confidence and respect of a growing community and well trained, self-administered police service, through effective interpersonal communication and managerial skills.

The successful applicant will be required to provide support, direction and leadership in developing and improving community partnerships, improving police and law enforcement services to a growing community, and in developing programs to prevent crime and protect life and property for people who live, play, work or travel through Rama First Nation. The ability to generate, impart and achieve a clear vision and meaningful strategies to support that vision is paramount.

The successful applicant must also have a comprehensive knowledge of police methods, administration, leadership, organization, problem-solving, community policing and community relations. In addition, the successful candidate must clearly demonstrate a superior level of knowledge of First Nations Communities and Culture. Seven (7) or more years of police work in a supervisory/managerial position is required.

Rama First Nation is an innovative employer offering a remuneration package that reflects the importance of this critical role. Compensation will be commensurate with the successful applicant's level of knowledge, skills, abilities and experience. Rama First Nation is offering this position on a five (5) year contract, commencing in September 2009. All those qualified are encouraged to apply.
