Background

The CPC Professional Development Centre for Aboriginal Policing is pleased to announce that it will be offering its **Senior Police Administration Course (SPAC)** on a First Nations territory, in Alberta, this fall. This three-week program will provide unique insight into leadership practices, strategic thinking and the ability to create high performance teams to meet current and future needs of police agencies responsible for delivering policing services to Aboriginal Communities.

The tuition fee for this delivery of the SPAC is \$750.00 for students from Canadian police services, \$2,250.00 for students from Canadian government agencies and \$3,000.00 for students from foreign countries. The registration and billing for this course will be done through the regular CPC registration process. Individual police agencies will be responsible for candidate accommodation, meals and travel arrangements. Accommodation, with continental breakfast included, is available at the **[Holiday Inn Express, 12025 Lake Fraser Drive, Calgary](#)** hiexgm@shawlink.ca (403)225-3000 at the cost of \$99 per night + taxes. As the course site is away from commercial food outlets, lunches will be available for purchase on site from a local FN caterer at a total cost of \$150.00 for the 15 course days . Shuttle service from the Hotel to the course site, on the Tsuu T'ina Nation, will be provided each day. Candidates from municipal and provincial agencies will be eligible for the CPC travel grant.
